

## **RESOLUTION NO. 2007-397**

Adopted by the Sacramento City Council

June 12, 2007

### **ESTABLISHING THE SOMATIC PRACTITIONER ESTABLISHMENT PERMIT FEE**

#### **BACKGROUND**

- A. The Law and Legislation Committee has recommended adoption of an ordinance to create the somatic practitioner establishment permit, which would allow a business to hire somatic practitioners as employees and to operate with more than the current limitation of 10 practitioners.
- B. The City needs to set the amount of the somatic practitioner establishment permit fee to cover staff costs to review the application and process the permit.

#### **BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:**

- Section 1. The City of Sacramento Fee and Charge Report is amended to include the following fees:

Somatic Practitioner Establishment Permit

Application: \$ 756.00

Renewal: \$103.00

- Section 2. Based on the information presented and in the public record and in compliance with the Public Resources Code Section 21080(b)(8), the City Council finds that the permit fees are for the purpose of meeting operating expenses, including employee wage rates and fringe benefits.
- Section 3. Authorize the City Manager to adjust department operating and revenue budgets to reflect the somatic practitioner establishment permit processing costs and revenues.
