ORDINANCE NO. 1508, FOURTH SERIES.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 18 OF ORDINANCE NO. 578, FOURTH SERIES, PASSED MAY 4, 1933, AND ENTITLED: "AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A PUBLIC POUND; CREATING THE OFFICE OF POUND MASTER; PROVIDING FOR ASSISTANTS TO THE POUND MASTER; PROVIDING FOR COMPENSATION; FIXING THE AMOUNT OF BOND TO BE FILED BY THE POUND MASTER; REGULATING THE KEEPING OF ANY HORSE, MULE, ASS, KINE, HOG, SHEEP OR GOAT; REGULATING THE KEEPING OF DOGS; PROVIDING THAT OWNERS OF DOGS MUST SECURE A PERMIT TO KEEP A DOG AND PROVIDING FOR THE REGISTRATION OF DOGS; MAKING IT UNLAWFUL FOR DOGS TO RUN AT LARGE OR BE PERMITTED IN A FOOD ESTABLISHMENT; PROVIDING FOR THE IMPOUNDING OF ANIMALS RUNNING AT LARGE AND THE MANNER IN WHICH SUCH ANIMALS MAY BE REDEEMED OR DISPOSED OF; REGULATING THE KEEPING OF DOGS SUSPECTED OF BEING AFFECTED WITH RABIES; MAKING IT UNLAWFUL FOR ANY PERSON TO HARBOR OR CONCEAL A DOG RUNNING AT LARGE; FIXING THE PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION OF THE PROVISIONS OF THIS ORDINANCE, AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 509, FOURTH SERIES, PASSED APRIL 30, 1931, AND ORDINANCE NO. 551, FOURTH SERIES, PASSED JUNE 9, 1931," AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 1199, FOURTH SERIES, PASSED AUGUST 23, 1946.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

SECTION 1: Section 18 of Ordinance No. 578, Fourth Series, passed May 4, 1933, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 18: Beginning with the first day of January next succeeding the obtaining of the permit to keep a dog and the registration of any dog, as hereinabove provided, the owner of said dog shall pay a registration fee of two dollars (\$2.00) per dog, said registration fee being payable from the first day of January to the first day of March of each year, inclusive. Any person, during the period above mentioned in this section, who keeps or harbors a dog within the corporate limits of the City of Sacramento, shall be required to pay the sum of \$2.50 for said registration fee in the event that such fee is not paid during said period.


SECTION 2: Ordinance No. 1199, Fourth Series, passed August 23, 1946, is hereby repealed.

SECTION 3: That the Clerk shall publish this ordinance once within ten days after passage in the official newspaper of said City of Sacramento.
