MINUTES OF LAW AND LEGISLATION COMMITTEE

January 16, 1986

4:00 P.M.

The meeting was called to order at 4:07 p.m. by Chairman Doug Pope. Also present were Bill Smallman and Dave Shore. Lynn Robie arrived late.

- 1. Support of Senate Bill No. 806 Community Parklands Act of 1986. Bill Smallman moved, Dave Shore seconded, and it was unanimously agreed to support this Senate bill.
- 2. Request for Resolution to Oppose Federal Legislation to Ease Handgun Ownership Laws. Dave Shore moved, Bill Smallman seconded, and it was unanimously agreed to oppose this legislation.
- 3. Ordinance Adding Section 71.155 and Amending Section 71.160, Relating to Hazardous Materials Disclosure. This was an add-on item presented by the Fire Department. Diane Balter, Deputy City Attorney, was present to discuss this matter with Committee members. She explained that the State of California passed new legislation relating to hazardous materials disclosure, which requires the County to administer unless a city assumes the responsibility by ordinance. The City of Sacramento does not want the County to administer the new state law, and therefore submitted this ordinance. Bill Smallman moved, Dave Shore seconded, and it was unanimously approved.

At this time, Dave Shore requested that the pit bull ordinance be discussed at a meeting soon. There was some discussion about the problem of pit bulls, and the fact that there are now only about 2-3 Animal Control employees picking up dogs at any one time in the City of Sacramento at the present time.

The meeting was adjourned at 4:10 p.m. to Executive Session.
