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ORDINANCE NO. 1467, FOURTH SERIES.

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING ANNEXATION OF UNINHABITED CONTIGUOUS TERRITORY TO THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO IN BLOCK BOUNDED BY NORTH B STREET, A STREET, 22ND AND 23RD STREETS, AND MAKING THIS ORDINANCE AN EMERGENCY MEASURE TO TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

WHEREAS, pursuant to petition for annexation, the Council of the City of Sacramento, by resolution duly passed on the 23rd day of September, 1949, duly initiated proceedings for the annexation of certain uninhabited contiguous territory hereinafter described to the City of Sacramento; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of the Annexation Act, a copy of said resolution was published at least once a week for two successive weeks prior to the hearing of said proceedings in The Sacramento Union, a newspaper of general circulation published in the City of Sacramento and the official newspaper of said City of Sacramento; and

WHEREAS, as provided in said resolution, the time and place for hearing protests was set for October 14, 1949, at 8:00 o'clock P.M. at the Council Chamber of the City of Sacramento, in the Sacramento City Hall at 9th and Eye Streets, in the City of Sacramento, California; and

WHEREAS, at said time, date and place no owner of property within the territory proposed to be annexed filed any written protest thereto and all other protests against said annexation were overruled; and

WHEREAS, it is to the best interests of the City of Sacramento that said uninhabited contiguous territory be annexed to said City of Sacramento,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

SECTION 1: That that certain uninhabited contiguous territory described as:

All those certain parcels of real property situate in the County of Sacramento, State of California, and particularly described as follows:

Beginning at the intersection of the North line of North B Street and the East line of 22nd Street, as shown on the Map of Part of Sacramento City filed in Sacramento County Recorder's office in Book 1 of Official Maps, Page 8; thence from said point of beginning, North along the said East line of 22nd Street a distance of thirty (30) feet; thence Easterly along a line parallel to and thirty (30) feet North of the North line of said North B Street to its intersection with the Northerly prolongation of the East line of 23rd Street as shown on said map of part of Sacramento City; thence South along said Northerly prolongation and along the said East line of 23rd Street to the North line of A Street, said line being a Northerly Boundary

of the City of Sacramento; thence Westerly along the Northerly line of A Street to its intersection with the Easterly line of 22nd Street; thence Northerly along the Easterly line of 22nd Street to the Point of Beginning.

SECTION 2: This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall take effect immediately; such emergency being that proceedings for closing the alleys shown on the maps within this area are now pending with the City and expect to be completed on October 21, 1949, and that it is necessary that this property be declared within the city prior to the adoption of the ordinance closing said alleys.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be published once in The Sacramento Union, a newspaper of general circulation published in the City of Sacramento and the official newspaper of said City of Sacramento.
