AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR TO SUBMIT A REQUEST FOR SUPPLEMENTARY TITLE VII FUNDS, TO THE CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF AGING AND THE A-95 REVIEW BOARD FOR THE SACRAMENTO ELDERLY NUTRITION PROGRAM AND TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT UPON THE APPROVAL OF THE REQUEST

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSING AUTHORITY OF THE COUNTY OF SACRAMENTO:

1. The Executive Director is authorized to submit a request for Supplemental Title VII Funds to the California Department of Aging for the Sacramento Elderly Nutrition Program.
2. The Executive Director is authorized to submit the request for Supplemental Title VII Funds for A-95 review.
3. The Executive Director is authorized to accept the Grant Award upon receipt of approval and to enter into Contracts from the California Department of Aging for the supplemental funds.

APPROVAL OF SELECTION CRITERIA FOR 102 SCATTERED
HOUSES FOR PUBLIC HOUSING (CAL. 5-19)

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSING AUTHORITY OF THE CITY OF
SACRAMENTO:

1. The Executive Director is hereby directed to use the following criteria as priorities in the site selection to acquire 102 scattered houses for low-rent public housing: (1) Houses which are (a) presently on the Section 23 Leased Housing Program, to minimize relocation of tenants; (b) brought up to acceptable standards by the Seller; and, (c) priced within prototype limits set by DHUD; and, (2) Locations which are (a) consistent with the Housing Assistance Plan; and, (b) reasonably near public transportation, shopping, and schools.

2. The Executive Director shall present the tentatively selected houses to the Housing Authority for final approval for purchase.
