SUBJECT: Approval of Plans and Specifications for Water Main
Relocation in Stockton Blvd. - Alhambra Blvd. and
34th Street

SUMMARY

The Division of Water and Sewers has prepared plans and specifications for the subject project. Approval and call for bids is requested.

BACKGROUND

A section of old 24" steel water main has deteriorated over the years due to corrosion and has become a maintenance problem. The Division proposes to replace this section of main. The project was originally advertised in August, 1978, and no bids were received. The project was readvertised in November, 1978, and all bids were rejected because of excessive costs. The project has been redesigned to provide a more cost-effective solution to the problem.

FINANCIAL DATA

This project was budgeted in the 1976-77 fiscal year Water Distribution Capital Improvements. Estimated cost of construction is \$79,500.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the plans and specifications be approved and that bids be received on June 24, 1980.
