

# RESOLUTION No. 755

Adopted by The Sacramento City Council on date of

WHEREAS, the costs involved in the construction of the Addition to the City Hall and the remodelling of the Council Chamber were slightly in excess of the sum heretofore appropriated by the City and those supplied by the United States Government under P. W. A., and

WHEREAS, payment of said construction will require an outlay of an additional sum of \$2,200.00,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

That the sum of \$2,200.00 be, and it is hereby, appropriated for said purpose from the Cash Basis Fund and to be returned when the next budget becomes effective.
