I. Local interest legislation. Status.

- (a) Board of Control Claims: Wharf demolition and waste to energy plant.
SB 2622 (Presley). Board of Control funding bill.

SB 1604 (Garamendi) Set for hearing June 15 in Assembly Water, Agriculture and Wildlife.
SB 2669 (Doolittle)
AB 1751 (Leslie). Dead.

AB 4355 (Connelly). City council members taken off the governing board in most recent amendments.
Likely the bill will go off the Assembly floor before June 10.
