

RESOLUTION APPROVING ASSESSMENT NO. 2476

Adopted by the Sacramento City Council on date of
July 10, 1942

WHEREAS, the Superintendent of Streets of the City of Sacramento has heretofore made and issued and filed with the City Clerk an Assessment, together with a Diagram and Engineer's Certificate, to represent the costs and expenses of improving 8th Avenue, from the westerly boundary of "Altamont Tract" (as the same is shown on the official map or plat thereof filed in the office of the County Recorder of the County of Sacramento, State of California),

in the City of Sacramento, the proceedings for the making of which improvement were initiated by the adoption of Resolution of Intention No. 2476;

WHEREAS, this is the time fixed by the City Clerk for the hearing by this Council upon said Assessment; and it is also the time fixed for the hearing of any appeal to this Council by any person interested in said work or in said Assessment; and


