As a young woman, renter, community organizer and public policy professional, I believe I can bring a different and unique perspective to the Ann Land & Bertha Henschel Memorial Fund Commission. This commission gives grants that impact the lives of the Sacramento community and it is imperative that individuals from diverse backgrounds, socioeconomic classes, and perspectives are a part of that process. I left home at the age of 16, worked several jobs while attending college full-time, and often found myself in precarious living situations while trying to balance these responsibilities without a support system. After several years attending community college, I moved to midtown and commuted four days a week during the entirety of my time at UC Davis. I have watched this great city grow and flourish in recent years. After many years of uncertainty about my future, wondering whether I would be able to pay for electricity or books, and experiencing regular concern over my ability to keep a roof over my head, I now am in a place where my goal is to ensure that the decisions our city makes protect all, especially those who need it most. I took this passion and used it during my time on the board of the Midtown Neighborhood Association before moving to New Era Park. I am a member of a variety of community organizations including Habitat for Humanity Young Professionals and Global Shapers Untapped, which partners with local non-profits each month to give back to the community. These include Next Move Sacramento, St. John's Women & Children's Shelter, and Make-A-Wish, to name a few. In addition to volunteering in the community, I also care deeply about gender equality in Sacramento. I am a member of several organizations that offer workshops and mentorship for women to develop skills, advance their careers, and participate in local governance. These include my previous role as Fundraising Director of the Fem Dems of Sacramento and member of the Women & Girls Advancement Coalition. Additionally, I completed the City Management Academy which helped me develop an understanding of how the city operates in order to more effectively address the issues that I feel passionately about.
