

RESOLUTION NO. 244

WHEREAS, in the development of the Municipal Airport of the City of Sacramento on Del Paso Park, it is necessary to have installed facilities for the supplying of electric energy and telephone and telegraph service at said airport, and that the construction of power and telegraph lines are indispensable to such service; and

WHEREAS, GREAT WESTERN POWER COMPANY OF CALIFORNIA, a California corporation, and PACIFIC TELEPHONE AND TELEGRAPH COMPANY, a California corporation, desire the right to construct power lines and telephone and telegraph lines for the accommodation and development of said Municipal Airport,

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

That permission is hereby granted to GREAT WESTERN POWER COMPANY OF CALIFORNIA, a California corporation, and PACIFIC TELEPHONE AND TELEGRAPH COMPANY, a California corporation, to erect, construct, repair, replace, maintain and use over, along, across and upon that portion of said Del Paso Park, hereinafter particularly described, for transmission and distribution of electricity, and for all purposes connected therewith, poles and wires suspended thereon and supported thereby, and all necessary or proper crossarms, braces, connections, guys, anchors, fastenings and other appliances and fixtures, and wires for telephone purposes, together with the right of ingress thereto and egress therefrom; also to make the necessary clearing for the purposes aforesaid.

That the lands included in said Del Paso Park above

mentioned are situate in the County of Sacramento, State of California, and particularly described as follows,

to-wit:

All of that certain lot, piece, parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being in Sections 16, 25, 28, 27, 31, 32, 39 and 40 Rancho Del Paso, known as Sacramento City Park, deeded to the City of Sacramento on the 27th day of February, 1914, by T. A. FARRELL, said deed being filed for record in the official records of Sacramento County, California, in Book 897 of Deeds at page 157 on the 28th day of February, 1914.

Line of poles and wires with necessary crossarms, braces, etc., is to be erected and maintained on, over and along a strip of ground 8 feet in width, the center line of which is approximately 50 feet northwesterly from and parallel with the center line of Auburn Boulevard, a State Highway. The westerly end of the said line of poles and wires, with necessary crossarms, braces, etc., is to begin at a point approximately 50 feet westerly from the westerly boundary line of Fulton Ave., a County Road, as said Fulton Avenue now exists south of said Auburn Boulevard and extends northeasterly along said center line a distance of approximately 1100 feet. An anchor is to be placed approximately 15 feet north of said center line and on line with a point approximately 5 feet east of the west line of the said Fulton Ave.

The City of Sacramento reserves the right to require the location of said line of poles and wires to be changed to another location, or to an underground conduit system, should such change be found necessary in order to fully and properly develop said Municipal Airport; provided that the cost of any such change would be borne by the City of Sacramento.

This permit is to remain in full force and effect so long as the said Municipal Airport is maintained at its present location at said Del Paso Park.

A certified copy of this resolution delivered to said Great Western Power Company of California and Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company shall operate

to vest in said corporations the rights and privileges
above set forth, subject to the conditions above
expressed.
