

RESOLUTION NO. 2152

RESOLUTION APPROVING ASSESSMENT
Adopted by the Sacramento City Council
on date of September 8th, 1927.

WHEREAS, the Superintendent of Streets of the City of Sacramento has heretofore made and issued and filed with the City Clerk, an assessment, together with a Diagram and Engineer's Certificate, to represent the cost and expense of improving streets, avenues, boulevard, ways and rights-of-way in and adjacent to "Swanston Park, Unit No. 1", (as the same is shown on the official map thereof filed in the office of the County Recorder of the County of Sacramento, State of California) in the City of Sacramento, the proceedings for the making of which improvement were initiated by the adoption of Resolution of Intention No. 2152; and,


WHEREAS, the time fixed by the City Clerk for the hearing by this City Council upon said assessment, was 8:00 o'clock P. M., August 25th, 1927, at which time, the said City Council did postpone the said hearing until 8:00 o'clock P. M., September 1st, 1927; and, WHEREAS, said hearing was further postponed until 8:00 o'clock P.M., September 8, 1927;

WHEREAS, this is the time fixed for the hearing by this Council upon said assessment, and it is also the time fixed for the hearing of any appeal to this Council by any person interested in said work, or in said assessment; and,

WHEREAS, no appeal has been taken to this Council by any person, and the City Council has heard evidence upon said Assessment and the Diagram and Engineer's Certificate attached thereto, and is satisfied with the correctness of the same;

IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that said Assessment, together with the Diagram and Engineer's Certificate attached thereto be, and the same are, hereby confirmed and approved in all respects as filed.
