## AGREEMENT FOR ADMINISTRATION OF CITY GENERAL FUNDS TO HUMAN RIGHTS/FAIR HOUSING COMMISSION

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

Section 1: The Executive Director is hereby authorized to execute an Amendment to the Memorandum of Understanding, a copy of which is attached to this resolution, with the City of Sacramento to administer an additional \$5,000 of City General Funds for the Human Rights/Fair Housing Commission.

Section 2: The Executive Director is hereby authorized to execute a contract with the Human Rights/Fair Housing Commission, in substantially the same form and substance as the existing contract between the Human Rights/Fair Housing Commission and the Agency and as approved by Agency Counsel, for an additional \$5,000 of City General Funds.

Section 3: The 1989 Agency budget is amended to include the revenue of \$5,000 as herein provided and to show said increase by a \$5,000 increase of the funds in the Human Rights/Fair Housing cost center C04259.

AMENDMENT TO  
MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING  
REGARDING FUNDING OF HUMAN RIGHTS/FAIR HOUSING  
SERVICES WITH THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO

RECITALS

WHEREAS, the City has entered into a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with the Agency to transfer \$30,000 of 1988/89 City General Funds to the Human Rights/Fair Housing Commission (HR/FHC) (Agreement #88155) to provide services to protect and monitor human rights and fair housing practices for persons within the City and County of Sacramento, and;

WHEREAS, the City has allocated an additional \$5,000 of 1988/89 City General Funds to the HR/FHC;

NOW THEREFORE, City and Agency agree as follows:

AGREEMENT

The City of Sacramento agrees to allocate and administer City General Funds to the Human Rights/Fair Housing Commission as follows:

1. City shall transfer to Agency an additional \$5,000 of general funds to be incorporated into the HR/FHC contract. Agency shall disburse said funds in accordance with the terms of the HR/FHC Agreement for 1989.
2. Either the City or Agency shall have the right to terminate this MOU upon forty-five (45) days written notice.
