

Resolution of Award No. 2585

Resolved, that the City Council of the City of Sacramento, having in open session on the 20th day of December 19 46, opened, examined, and publicly declared all sealed proposals or bids offered for the doing of the street work hereinafter mentioned,

Hereby rejects all of said bids, except that next hereinafter mentioned, and hereby awards the contract for said work to the lowest regular, responsible bidder, to-wit:

To A. TEICHERT & SON, INC.,

at the prices specified in its proposal for said work now on file.


The work herein referred to is the improvement of 41st Street from the northerly line of 11th Avenue to the northerly boundary of Forty-First Street Terrace (as the same is shown on the official plat thereof filed in the office of the Sacramento County Recorder) and 11th Avenue from the westerly line of 41st Street to a point 48.05 feet westerly thereof and 100 feet easterly of the easterly line of 41st Street

in the City of Sacramento to the extent, with the materials and in the manner set forth in Resolution of Intention No. 2585, passed and adopted by said City Council on November 7th 19 46, reference to which Resolution of Intention is hereby made for a description of said work and improvement.

The City Clerk is hereby directed to publish notice of this award twice in the Sacramento Union a daily newspaper published and circulated in said City of Sacramento, as required by law.
