

RESOLUTION RESCINDING STANDARD SPECIFICATIONS AND ADOPTING NEW STANDARD SPECIFICATIONS IN LIEU THEREOF

RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Sacramento,
that the specifications entitled "Standard Specifications for
the improvement of Streets and Alleys and for the Construction
of Sewers," originally approved by the City Council on December
21, 1922, and which were automatically rescinded on May 2, 1941,
and re-adopted on May 16, 1941, BE, AND THE SAME ARE, HEREBY
RESCINDED AND SET ASIDE; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the revised set of specifica-
tions entitled "Standard Specifications for the Improvement of
Streets and Alleys and for the Construction of Sewers," submitted
by the City Engineer on March 20, 1942, the provisions of which
are intended to cover all phases of work constructed on streets,
alleys and right-of-ways, the costs and expenses of which work
are to be paid by special assessment upon private property,
BE, AND THE SAME ARE, HEREBY APPROVED AND ADOPTED, EFFECTIVE
ON THIS DATE.
