

Resolution of Award No. 2483

Resolved, that the City Council of the City of Sacramento, having in open session on the 19th day of June, 1942, opened, examined, and publicly declared all sealed proposals or bids offered for the doing of the street work hereinafter mentioned,

Hereby rejects all of said bids, except that next hereinafter mentioned, and hereby awards the contract for said work to the lowest regular, responsible bidder, to-wit:

To McGillivray Construction Co.

at the prices specified in its proposal for said work now on file.

The work herein referred to is the improvement of Muir Way, from the center line of Broadway (formerly known as "Y" Street), to the southerly boundary of "Wright & Kimbrough Industrial Tract" (as the same is shown on the official map or plat thereof filed in the office of the County Recorder of the County of Sacramento, State of California); and right-of-way, owned by the City of Sacramento, along the proposed extension of the said Muir Way, from the southerly boundary of said "Wright & Kimbrough Industrial Tract," to a sewer in place in an easement owned by the City of Sacramento, said easement being along the westerly projection of the center line of Fremont Way,

in the City of Sacramento to the extent, with the materials and in the manner set forth in Resolution of Intention No. 2483, passed and adopted by said City Council on April 17, 1942, reference to which Resolution of Intention is hereby made for a description of said work and improvement, and of the district to be assessed for the costs and expenses of said work.




