

ORDINANCE NO. 1463, FOURTH SERIES

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 669, FOURTH SERIES, PASSED JUNE 27, 1935, AND ENTITLED: "AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE LICENSING AND REGULATION OF DANCING IN PLACES WHERE LIQUORS ARE SOLD; PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION OF THIS ORDINANCE; REPEALING SECTION 4 OF ORDINANCE NO. 317, THIRD SERIES, PASSED OCTOBER 11, 1917, AND MAKING THIS ORDINANCE AN EMERGENCY MEASURE TO TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY," BY ADDING SUBDIVISION 6 TO SECTION 3 OF SAID ORDINANCE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
SACRAMENTO:


SECTION 1: Ordinance No. 669, Fourth Series, passed June 27, 1935, is hereby amended by adding Subdivision 6 to Section 3 of said Ordinance:

Subdivision 6: The area bounded as follows:

Beginning at a point in the center of 16th Street and "R" Street, thence easterly along the centerline of "R" Street a distance of 120 feet; thence southerly parallel with 16th Street to the center of Broadway; thence westerly a distance of 240 feet; thence northerly and parallel to 16th Street to the centerline of "R" Street; thence easterly along the centerline of "R" Street to the point of beginning.
