

RESOLUTION NO. 2004-178

ADOPTED BY THE SACRAMENTO CITY COUNCIL

ON DATE OF MAR 16 2004

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH THE LAW ENFORCEMENT CHAPLAINCY-SACRAMENTO.

WHEREAS, the Law Enforcement Chaplaincy-Sacramento is a non-profit religious organization that organizes and directs volunteer chaplains who are trained in post traumatic event counseling and critical incident stress management.

WHEREAS, the Law Enforcement Chaplaincy-Sacramento provides secular critical incident response services including: post-traumatic incident counseling to law enforcement employees, their immediate families and the community; assisting officers at crime scenes, accidents, or other tragedies by providing comfort and counseling to crime victims, as well as people who have witnessed, suffered, or been affected by a serious injury, trauma, or both; and upon request, providing counseling and support to individuals and families coping with death, injury, grief and crime.

WHEREAS, the City of Sacramento desires to contract with Law Enforcement Chaplaincy-Sacramento to provide secular critical incident response services through the use of the Law Enforcement Chaplaincy-Sacramento.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO THAT:

1. The City Manager, or a designated representative is hereby authorized to execute an agreement on behalf of the City of Sacramento that allows the Law Enforcement Chaplaincy-Sacramento to provide critical incident response services.
2. The City Manager, or a designated representative is hereby authorized to provide a vehicle (including maintenance and fuel), two portable radios and \$16,000 per contract year, with a maximum potential term of five years beyond June 30, 2003.
