Bob Thomas, Director of Parks and Community Services, reported that, as directed by City Council, staff investigated the possibility of the Senior Gleaners using the eastern 105 feet of the Longview property for their immediate parking needs. Mr. Thomas informed the Committee that, after a meeting between the Senior Gleaners and the Arcade Creek Restoration Committee, it was determined that the property would not be appropriate for use at this time because regeneration of the blue oaks is occurring in this area. Therefore, arrangements were made with the Sacramento Horsemen's Association to use their site as a temporary parking area for the Senior Gleaners.
