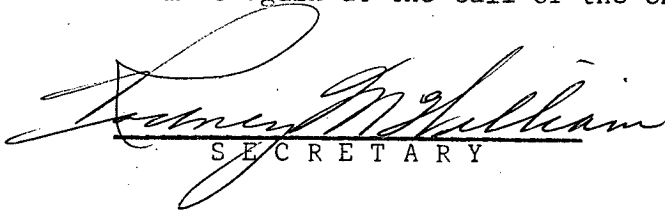

ZOO ATTENDANT EXAMINATION NO. 842:

Communication from Reg Renfree,

Director of Recreation and Parks

Department, dated October 1, 1964, outlining problems involved in the recruitment of candidates for Zoo Attendant examination, was read and considered.

Because of problems involved in recruiting anyone from outside the city service with experience in caring for animals, birds, and reptiles, it was the order of the Board that the next examination be held on a promotional basis for city employees only limited to eligibility in those classes in the labor and trades category with a maximum salary of less than \$500 per month.
