SUMMARY

Freeport Renovation on the Move (FROM) has been invited to present a Neighborhood Report to the City Council to discuss issues, concerns, and accomplishments for its community.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

One of the responsibilities of the Neighborhoods, Planning, and Development Services Department is to serve as a liaison with neighborhood associations and residents to improve their communities and to address various issues and problems. This provides the staff with the opportunity to work closely with active neighborhood residents, associations, and businesses. FROM, located in Council District 8 in Neighborhood Service Area 2, has been invited to present a Neighborhood Reports to the City Council. The association

presentation may include, but not be limited to, the following subjects:

- Parks & Recreation Issues: Development and construction of a new community center for the Freeport area to replace the Evelyn Moore Community Center. Need for more youth and senior programs. Replacement of existing playground equipment.
- Thurgood Marshall Senior High School: Concerns regarding security and impact of student behavior on the surrounding neighborhood.
- Neighborhood Improvement: Ongoing efforts to address problems and to enhance the neighborhood.

None. No goods or services being purchased.

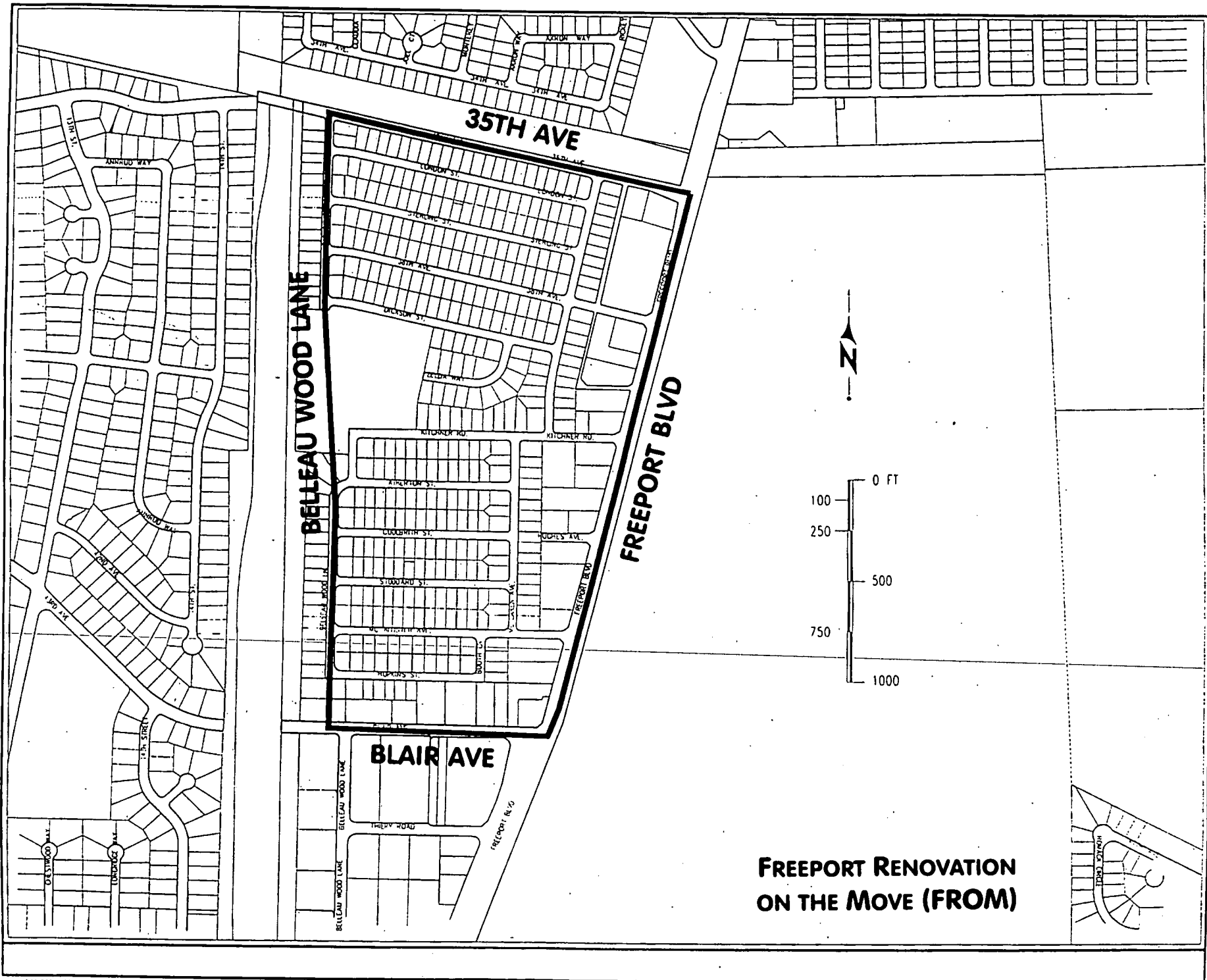
