SUMMARY

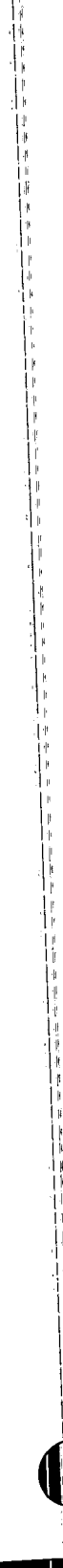
This report recommends that the City Council reject all bids received under Bid No. 1582 for a Shallow River Patrol Boat, adopt the attached revised specifications, and order the City Clerk to call for bids under Bid No. 1582-A. The revision of the specifications is necessary in order to comply with the requirements of a State of California grant, which will provide a major portion of the funding for the purchase of the shallow river patrol boat.

RECOMMENDATION

The Department of General Services, on behalf of the Police Department, recommends that the City Council reject all responses to Bid No. 1582, adopt the attached revised specifications and order the City Clerk to call for bids for a Shallow River Patrol Vessel under Bid No. 1582-A.

BACKGROUND

On September 1, 1992, the City Council adopted specifications for Bid No. 1582 for the purchase of a Police Shallow River Patrol Vessel. After receipt of the bids on September 30, 1992, the City was notified by the State of California Department of Boating and Waterways, that the bid specifications needed to be revised in order to meet current State Grant bidding requirements. Therefore, staff is recommending that the bid responses to Bid No. 1582 be rejected by Council and that Council adopt the attached revised specifications and readvertise for bids under Bid No. 1582-A.



FINANCIAL DATA

The State of California Department of Boating and Waterways has contracted with the City of Sacramento to grant 75% of the purchase price of the patrol boat. The total amount of the grant shall not exceed \$30,000.00. It is estimated that the City's share of the costs will not exceed \$10,000.00.


POLICY CONSIDERATIONS
