

RESOLUTION NO. 2006-304

Adopted by the Sacramento City Council

May 9, 2006

APPROVING THE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO AND RECLAMATION DISTRICT 1000 (RD 1000) FOR PHASE I DEVELOPMENT OF THE WALT UEDA PARKWAY BIKE TRAIL, CIP HB16 AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE AGREEMENT

BACKGROUND:

- A. The Walt Ueda Parkway Bike Trail consists of approximately 12.5 miles of paved recreation trails that are mostly on the crown of levees and offers visual access to the natural habitat of Steelhead, Arcade, Dry and Robla Creeks; Phase I development of this trail will be for approximately 4 miles of paved trail.
- B. The design of the project must take many factors into consideration, including sensitive habitat, natural amenities, ramps that are ADA accessible, appropriate access to neighborhoods, and a flood control infrastructure that includes levees and flood easements.
- C. The County owns easements on much of the trail alignment. RD 1000 maintains the levees on which the trail will be located. RD1000 and the City of Sacramento need to enter into an agreement to address levee and trail maintenance and operation, trail closures, and emergency response during flood events.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. Approves the Agreement between the City of Sacramento and Reclamation District 1000 (RD 1000) for Phase I development of the Walt Ueda Parkway Bike Trail, CIP HB16.
- Section 2. Authorizes the City Manager to execute the Agreement.


