MINUTES:

Norman Covell, Director of the County Environmental Management Department reviewed the background of the departmental consolidation. He explained that the County Toxics Task Force Final Report had included a recommendation to reorganize the air pollution control, environmental health, and hazardous materials management functions into a single County Department. Mr. Covell told the committee that the funding for the Department and the structure, scope, and composition of the City/County advisory commission were still under study.

In response to a question from Committee Chair Robie, Mr. Covell explained that SACOG will continue to serve as the lead agency for regional air quality planning unless AB 4355 passes and alters the organizational structure.
