SUBJECT: Rejection of Bids for the Purchase of Hazardous Materials Suits  
and Accessories

SUMMARY:

The Fire Department has a requirement for nine additional hazardous materials suits with accessories. It is recommended that, in the best interest of the City, the City Council reject all bids for the purchase of these suits.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

Formal bids (Bid No. 764) were solicited by the City Council on January 7, 1985 and one bid and two no-bids were received on February 5, 1985 (see attached).

Staff has reviewed the bid received and determined that it was non-responsive. The exceptions the vendor took with the bid and the high cost of his offering are not in the best interests of the City.

The Fire Department will re-evaluate the equipment specifications and re-submit these items for bid at a later date.

RECOMMENDATION:

It is therefore recommended that, pursuant to Section 57.305 of the Sacramento City Code, the City Council reject the bid received.


