

ORDINANCE NO. 1619, FOURTH SERIES.

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO HAVE TWO (2) TEST WELLS DRILLED AT THE SITE OF THE PROPOSED SEWAGE TREATMENT PLANT, WITHOUT FIRST ADVERTISING FOR BIDS, PURSUANT TO SECTION 251 OF THE CITY CHARTER, AND MAKING THIS ORDINANCE AN EMERGENCY MEASURE TO TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

SECTION 1: The City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to have two (2) TEST WELLS DRILLED at the site of the proposed Sewage Treatment Plant, without first advertising for bids, pursuant to Section 251 of the City Charter. The cost of said wells to be \$10,050.00, to be appropriated out of BOND FUND; such course having been recommended by the City Manager.


SECTION 2: This ordinance is hereby made an emergency measure and shall take effect immediately; such emergency being the immediate need of drilling said wells in order to determine the quality and quantity of water available at the site of the proposed Sewage Treatment Plant.
