

RESOLUTION No. 44

Adopted by The Sacramento City Council on date of

WHEREAS, the practice seems to be growing of constructing canopies or coverings (not awnings or marquees) over the sidewalk from the property line to the gutter, supported by posts fitted into holes cut in the sidewalk, at places for which there is no public convenience and necessity,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

That no cuts or holes be made in the sidewalk and no covering be placed over the sidewalk, other than movable awnings or marquees, without first getting a permit from the City Council. Such structure shall conform as to location, materials to be used, and method of construction to the requirements of the Building Inspector.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: That any such structure constructed without a permit from the Building Inspector is hereby declared to be a public nuisance, and all persons constructing and maintaining such structure shall be held so responsible.
