

RESOLUTION NO. 2009-237

Adopted by the Sacramento City Council

April 21, 2009

FUNDING FROM THE SACRAMENTO-YOLO MOSQUITO AND VECTOR CONTROL DISTRICT FOR THE PURCHASE OF GREEN WASTE CONTAINERS

BACKGROUND

- A. The South Side Park Neighborhood Association located in the downtown area has requested to participate in the Voluntary Green Waste Containerized Program.
- B. The Sacramento-Yolo Mosquito & Vector Control District Board approved funding for 600 green waste containers to be delivered to the residents of South Side Park Neighborhood Association.
- C. Containerized green waste will prevent organic matter from being washed into the combined storm water drainage system, and thereby decrease the habitat for mosquitoes to lay eggs and multiply. By decreasing the habitat for mosquitoes, the amount of insecticide needed to prevent the spread of mosquitoes will be lowered, decreasing the exposure by local residents to insecticide when spraying for mosquitoes.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. The City Manager or designee is authorized to accept on behalf of the City funds in the amount of \$30,000 from the Sacramento-Yolo Mosquito and Vector Control District for the purchase of 600 green waste containers for distribution to the residents of the South Side Park Neighborhood Association.


