PHILIP NOTO**

**IT IS HEREBY NOTED** that a great loss was suffered with the passing of Philip Noto on the 8th day of September, 1987, in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, at the age of 98 years; and

**WHEREAS**, Philip Noto came to the United States of America from Italy in 1910 in search of better opportunity; and

**WHEREAS**, Philip Noto, although he had not yet gained his United States citizenship, distinguished himself as a true and loyal American, serving in the United States Army during World War I, receiving wounds in France which hospitalized him; and

**WHEREAS**, Philip Noto was a honorable and hardworking man whose career spanned many years as a long-term employee of the Philadelphia Naval Yard; and

**WHEREAS**, Philip Noto was the loving father of three children, Mary Jane, Joseph and Anne, with whom he instilled the high work ethic and self-sufficiency they would need to be successful in their own lives; and

**WHEREAS**, this Council believes it proper that its minutes and the official records of the City of Sacramento recognize the passing of Philip Noto and so, has caused this Resolution to be prepared;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED** that this Resolution be entered with the minutes of this meeting, in addition to which, this meeting shall be adjourned in respect for the memory of Philip Noto.

**AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that a suitable copy of this Resolution be tendered to his bereaved family, as an expression of this Council's deepest sympathy.
