

Sacramento, California,

The communication received from Baylies C. Clark, City Engineer, with reference to the temporary appointment of D. B. Smith to the classification of Junior Engineer, which was discussed by the Board at their meeting of November 25th and laid over, was next given consideration by the Board. Upon motion by Commissioner Mason, seconded by Commissioner Weisman, and unanimously carried, the communication was referred back to the Engineering Department.

Upon motion by Commissioner Mason, seconded by Commissioner Weisman, and unanimously carried, the Secretary was instructed to refer the complete file concerning the case of Milton F. Faig and Paul Manby to the City Attorney for an opinion.

The examination for Detective Sergeant and Desk Sergeant in the Police Department, and Engineer in the Fire Department were next taken under consideration by the Board. The examination for Detective Sergeant was approved by the Board, and the Secretary was instructed to revise the examinations for Engineer and Desk Sergeant and present them to the Board for their approval at the next meeting.

There being no further business, the Board adjourned at 9:10 o'clock P.M. to meet again at 8:00 o'clock P.M. on December 4, 1929.
