

## **RESOLUTION NO. 2019-0167**

Adopted by the Sacramento City Council

May 21, 2019

### **Suspend the Competitive Bidding Process for a Request for Proposals (RFP) Process for the Shared-Rideables Bike Rack Procurement (K15195100)**

#### **BACKGROUND**

- A. On April 2, 2019, City Council adopted an ordinance amending Chapter 5.18 and Chapter 10.76 of the Sacramento City Code regulating the Shared-Rideable Businesses. The amendments place the responsibility of the installation of bike racks on the City using funds associated with the Shared-Rideable Business Permit.
- B. In a continuing effort to obtain the best and most appropriate bike racks for the needs of the City, staff recommends the City Council act to suspend the typical competitive bid process and instead use an RFP process. As with any other supply contract, staff will return to City Council for approval to award any resultant bike rack purchase of \$100,000 or more.
- C. City Code Section 3.56.230(c) authorizes the City Council to suspend competitive bidding for the purchase of supplies when, upon a two-thirds vote, the City Council determines it is in the best interests of the City to do so. It is in the City's best interest to suspend competitive bidding for the purchase of bike racks in order to select multiple vendors that offer bike racks which fit the varying needs of the City. The purchases will take place over the course of no more than three years without returning to the City Council for approval. Staff will return to City Council for approval to award any resultant bike rack purchase of \$100,000 or more.

#### **BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:**

- Section 1. In the best interests of the City, competitive bidding is suspended for the purchase of bike racks used in the City's Shared-Rideable program and is replaced by the RFP process to identify vendors with bike racks that meet the varying needs of the City, for maximum period of three years.
