

MINUTES OF CIVIL SERVICE BOARD
CITY OF SACRAMENTO
SPECIAL MEETING

January 10, 1936.

The Civil Service Board met in special session in the office of the Board at 8:20 P.M., President Deise presiding.

PRESENT: Commissioners Chenu, Stacy, President Deise.
ABSENT: none.

NOTICES OF APPOINTMENT

Captains H. M. Heiser and T. W.

Baker of the Fire Department

appeared and discussed the possi-

bility of securing notices for each employee, giving the date of appointment in city service. After discussion the Secretary was instructed to prepare notices for all city employees, giving their date of appointment and whether or not each employee had civil service standing, was a temporary appointee, or exempt under the provisions of the Charter.

LEONARD, JAMES E.

Mr. Leonard appeared and requested reconsideration of the Board's decision of November 21, 1935. After

discussion and review of letters received from Chief of Police W. M. Hallanan and Police Commissioner R. E. Mittelstaedt, he was informed that it would be impossible to change the decision.

SILVA, GEORGE

Mr. Silva, an employee in the Park Department, appeared and informed the Board that his name had been

removed from the Auto Mechanic's Eligible Register #41, February 5, 1935, because notice of certification was undelivered by postal

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authorities. He stated that he had moved, leaving a change of address at the post office and could not understand why his letter had not reached him. He was advised that he would be informed later as to the Board's decision. Later in the evening, after discussion Commissioner Chenu moved that Mr. Silva's name be restored to the list. Seconded by Commissioner Stacy and unanimously carried.

CARRIGAN, JAMES J.

Mr. Carrigan appeared and informed the Board that he had had five months and fifteen days employment from the Laborer's Eligible Register, which was recently abolished, and then was employed from the Truck Driver's list for a short period of time, hence did not complete six months probationary employment as a Laborer. He asked the Board if it would not be possible to give him sufficient credit for his employment as a Laborer so that he would be on a lay-off list instead of upon the new eligible list where his name appears opposite number seventy-five. He was informed that he would be advised later of the Board's decision. Later in the evening, and after discussion, Commissioner Stacy moved that due to the requirement of the Rules that employees must have served six months in order to secure permanent appointments, that Mr. Carrigan's request be denied. Seconded by Commissioner Chenu and unanimously carried.

LINEMAN'S EXAMINATION NO. 86

After discussing the announcement for this examination Commissioner Chenu moved that the age limit of forty-five years be stricken out. Seconded by Commissioner Stacy and unanimously carried. After discussion the Secretary was instructed

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to notify those who were under twenty-one years of age that it was the opinion of the Board that they could not continue with the examination.

WATCHMAN'S LIST

After discussing sources of appointment for this position, it was the order of the Board that they should come from existing city employees and from those who were incapacitated to carry on their regular duties, but were determined by the City Physician to be fit for Watchmen.


