# RESOLUTION No. 292

Adopted by The Sacramento City Council on date of

WHEREAS, the CITY OF SACRAMENTO is vitally interested in the repairs and reinforcement of levees and works of the Sacramento River Flood Control Project situated within the Sacramento Valley and which were damaged by flood waters during the winter of 1937-38, and


WHEREAS, it has been ascertained that The Reclamation Board and the Department of Public Works of the State of California have exhausted all funds that are applicable to said repairs and reinforcement, and that the available funds which have been applied to the repairs are insufficient to bring to a fair degree of safety the said levees of said project, and,

WHEREAS, said Reclamation Board and Department of Public Works have made application to Governor Merriam for funds in the amount of \$487,600. for the purpose of repairing said levees and works of said flood control project,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council that Governor Merriam be earnestly requested to give immediate consideration to the application of said Board and Department to the purpose that said repairs may be undertaken and completed prior to the coming winter season for the safety and protection of the people and property within this District.
