

RESOLUTION No. 47

Adopted by The Sacramento City Council on date of

WHEREAS, the City of Sacramento has for years conducted Camp Sacramento as a non-profit family summer camp for the citizens of Sacramento at lower rates than those of any other municipally operated summer camp, and even at such camp rates have been increased as much as thirty per cent, and

WHEREAS, during the past few months, board supplies have increased considerably, and, in order that the camp may be operated in a self-supporting manner, it is necessary to raise the present rates approximately twenty-five per cent,


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

That the rates for Camp Sacramento be increased over the 1941 rate in accordance with the following table:-
