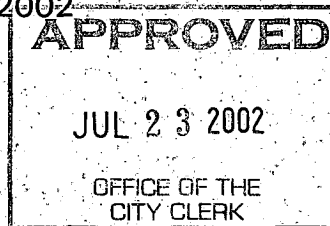

**SUBJECT: RESOLUTION TO PROHIBIT ALL PARKING ON PORTIONS OF BRUCEVILLE AND CALVINE ROADS**

**LOCATION AND COUNCIL DISTRICT:**

Bruceville Road from Consumes River Boulevard to Calvine Road and Calvine Road from Center Parkway to Bruceville Road. Council District 8.

**RECOMMENDATION:**

It is recommended that the City Council adopt the attached resolution prohibiting all parking along portions of Bruceville Road and Calvine Road.

**SUMMARY:**

This report recommends prohibiting all parking on the west side of Bruceville Road from Consumes River Boulevard to Calvine Road and on the north side of Calvine Road from Center Parkway to Bruceville Road (Exhibit A). Although signs are not posted, truck parking is prohibited at these locations. However, despite enforcement efforts, commercial vehicles (big rigs) continue to park creating noise and traffic problems for area residents. Erecting "No parking" signs and prohibiting all parking will warn potential violators that parking is indeed prohibited. The posting of signs has worked well at other problem locations where big rigs have parked illegally.

**COMMITTEE/COMMISSION ACTION:**

None.

**BACKGROUND INFORMATION:**

- Late last year the City's Code Enforcement Division was asked to address a problem with commercial trucks (big rigs) parking along portions of Bruceville and Calvine Roads.
- Although commercial vehicles are prohibited from parking in this area they have continue to park creating noise and traffic problems for residents. Enforcement efforts have not resolved the problem.
- It was requested that "No parking" signs be erected to help warn potential violators of this no parking area. The posting of signs has worked well in other problem areas.
- A letter was sent to the adjacent residents that may be impacted by this change which outlined the request and asked for comments.
- There was no opposition to the proposal.

**FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS:**

The cost to implement the recommended parking restriction is estimated to be \$2,000 for the installation of regulatory signs. Funds are available in the On-Street Parking operating budget.

**ENVIRONMENTAL CONSIDERATIONS:**

The Neighborhoods, Planning and Development Services Department, Office of Environmental Affairs has reviewed the project and has determined that this project is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) under Section 15301(c) of the CEQA guidelines



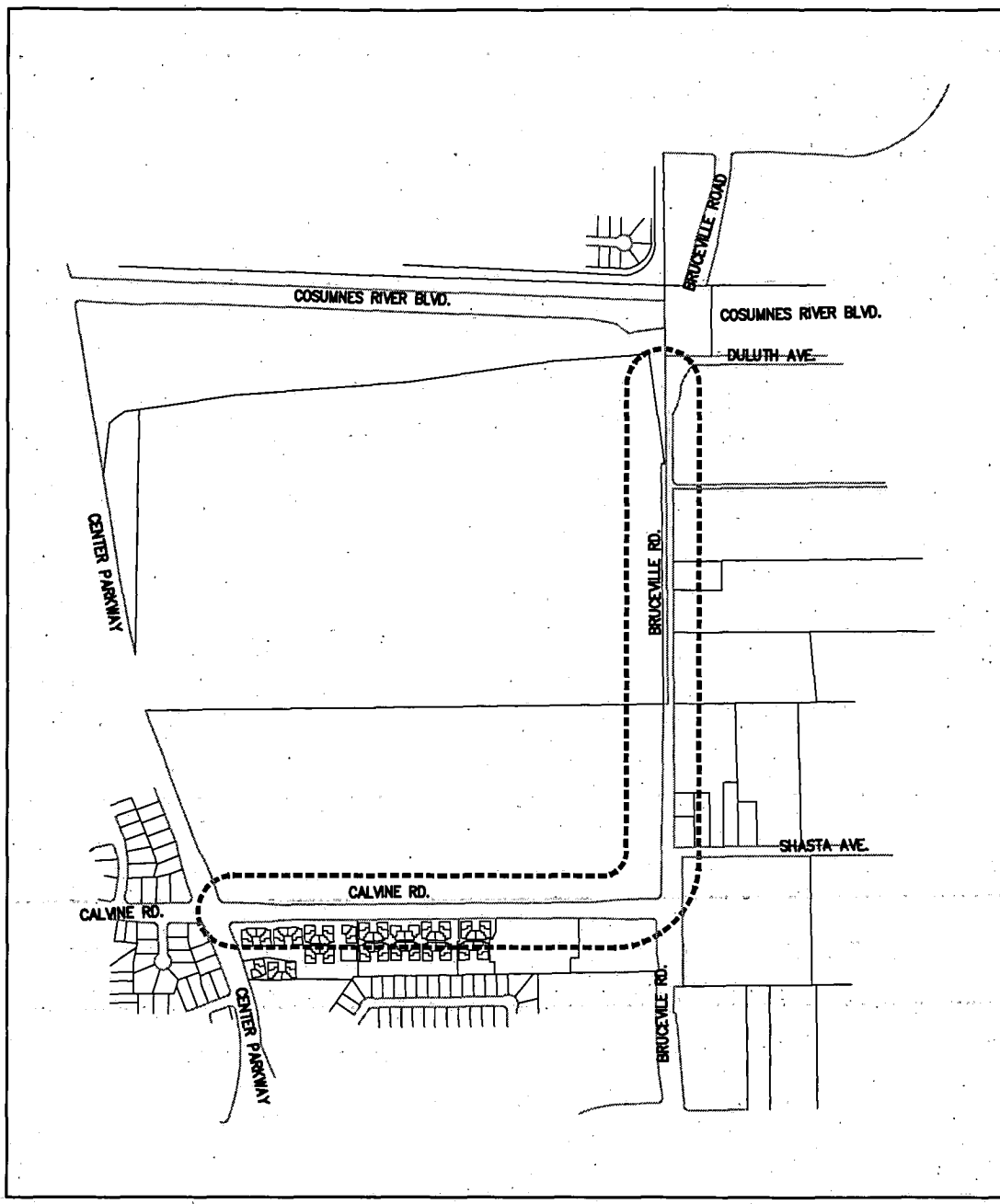

**RESOLUTION PROHIBITING ALL PARKING ON BRUCEVILLE ROAD AND CALVINE ROAD**

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Section 10.36.020 of the Sacramento City Code, when authorized signs are erected giving notice thereof, no person shall stop, stand or park a vehicle at any time upon any of the streets described in resolutions duly adopted by the city council.

**THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO THAT:**

All parking shall be prohibited on the following streets:

- Bruceville Road, west side, from Consumes River Boulevard to Calvine Road.
- Calvine Road, north side, from Center Parkway to Bruceville.
