

RESOLUTION No. 799

Adopted by The Sacramento City Council on date of

November 4th, 1937

WHEREAS, the Regular Municipal Election was held in the City of Sacramento on the 2nd day of November, 1937, pursuant to the provisions of Article XXI of the City Charter, now in force, for the purpose of electing nine (9) members of the City Council to serve for a term of Two (2) years, beginning January 1, 1938 and ending December 31, 1939; and

WHEREAS, the vote and returns of said election, have this day been canvassed by the City Council of the City of Sacramento, convening as a Canvassing Board and the results duly ascertained, other than as to the ballots of absent voters,


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, DETERMINED AND DECLARED, that the total number of votes cast by the electors at said election, other than the ballots of absent voters, was 22,709.

That the total number of City Councilmen to be elected was nine (9).

That the following candidates, being all of the candidates voted for at said election, received the number of votes set opposite their names respectively, (other than votes from absent voters), to-wit:
