## A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO, CALIFORNIA ESTABLISHING PRIORITY IN THE SELECTION OF WRITTEN ARGUMENTS REGARDING A CITY MEASURE

**WHEREAS**, a General Municipal Election is to be held on November 2, 2004, at which there will be submitted to the voters a measure pertaining to a parcel tax for additional library services;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO THAT:**

Section 1: That the City Council authorizes all members of the Council to file a written argument in favor of or against a City measure, accompanied by the printed names and signatures of the persons submitting it, in accordance with Article 4, Chapter 3, Division 9 of the Elections Code of the State of California; and to change the argument until and including the date fixed by the City Clerk after which no arguments for or against the City measure may be submitted to the City Clerk.

Section 2: That the City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this resolution and enter it into the book of original resolutions.
