

RESOLUTION No. 27

Adopted by The Sacramento City Council on date of
April 5, 1934

WHEREAS, the City Council of said City of Sacramento did heretofore cause to be prepared in accordance with law plans and specifications for an addition to the City Hall (P.W.A. Docket No. 3807 - City Hall) and did thereafter approve and adopt said plans and specifications and did cause to be published in the manner and for the time required by law a notice inviting sealed proposals for the performance of said work in accordance with the said plans and specifications, and


WHEREAS, in response to such notice, a number of contractors did submit to the City Council in the manner and within the time specified sealed proposals for the performance of such work in accordance with said plans and specifications, and

WHEREAS, the City Council did thereafter in the manner prescribed by law, publicly open, examine and canvass the proposals submitted in response to the notice above mentioned and did, as a result of such examination and canvass, determine that the Campbell Construction Company was the lowest and best bidder for the performance of said work;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

That the contract for the performance of said work be, and it is hereby, awarded to said Campbell Construction Company in the amount of \$67,776.00 and the Mayor and City Clerk are hereby instructed to prepare said contract and, upon its execution by said Campbell Construction Company, execute and deliver same.
