

# RESOLUTION No. 53

Adopted by The Sacramento City Council on date of  
May 31st, 1928

PROVIDING FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF COMMITTEES TO INVESTIGATE AND STUDY THE MANY PROBLEMS CONNECTED WITH OUR MUNICIPAL GOVERNMENT.

WHEREAS, there are many problems connected with our Municipal Government that require investigation and study on the part of the members of the Council, so that the same may be properly solved and intelligently disposed of; and

WHEREAS, it is in the interest of expediency that such investigations and studies be carried on by apportioning the work among the members of the Council.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Sacramento, and by the members thereof, that the Chairman of this Council appoint the following committees, namely:


1. Police

6. Sanitation and Public Health

8. Water and Wharves
