Extending Appreciation to Tony Muljat for his Dedication in the Arrest of Theodore J. Kaczynski in the Unabomb Case

WHEREAS, Tony Muljat served 25 years as a Postal Inspector for the Northern California region, headquartered in Sacramento, California and retired on April 24, 1997; and

WHEREAS, Tony Muljat was a principal investigator on the Unabomb Task Force which was established in 1985 to arrest serial bomber Theodore J. Kaczynski and was widely known for his unwavering dedication to the case and his tenacious pursuit of the suspect; and

WHEREAS, the community of Sacramento, and indeed the entire country, was shocked and terrorized by the injuries and murders committed by Kaczynski including the 1985 murder of Hugh Scrutton and the 1994 murder of lobbyist Gilbert Murray in a downtown Sacramento bombing; and

WHEREAS, Tony Muljat's 11 years of work, in the Unabomb Task Force culminated in the April 3, 1996 arrest of Theodore J. Kaczynski in Lincoln, Montana and the January 22, 1998 conviction of Kaczynski in Sacramento when he was sentenced to life in prison without the possibility of parole.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mayor and Council of the City of Sacramento, that we do hereby recognize and commend Tony Muljat for his exemplary work for the public safety of citizens of Sacramento and the U.S. and extend our appreciation for his dedication and perseverance on this most important case.
