The September 10, 1981 meeting of the Sacramento Metropolitan Arts Commission was called to order at 4:40 p.m. by Chair Hansen. This meeting was held at the Coloma Community Center in the Arts Resource Center, 4632 T Street, Sacramento.

All of the Commission's staff was present and everyone was introduced. A guest and former employee currently with the C.A.C., Lorraine Garcia, was present.

Chair Hansen described the Committees and talked about the need to review roles and establish goals for the "Research and Planning" Committee. The draft of a paper prepared two years ago outlining the roles of "Commissioners," "Executive Director" and "Staff" was distributed.

Jennifer Dowley the Coordinator for the Art in Public Places Program presented a slide show of public art nationwide which gave different examples of works and sites. She discussed the importance of appropriateness of artwork to the site. There also was discussion of working with the architects in the planning stages and integrating the artwork and the consideration of sociological features of the area.

Director Moskin announced an unsolicited gift from Citizens Savings and Loan Association for the October 1 and 2 conference. They will be providing black vinyl conference folders with gold imprint and pens for the participants.

A "Calendar of 1981 Activities" listing local arts events was distributed. It was suggested that this be done four times a year.

A speech entitled, "The New Renaissance: Corporate Support for the Arts" by Mr. Aldo Papone, Executive Vice President of Dayton Hudson Corporation, was distributed. The speech had been presented at the Sacramento Chamber of Commerce on August 10, 1981.

The next Commission meeting will be held on Tuesday, October 6, 1981 at 4:00 p.m. at the Housing and Redevelopment Agency, first floor conference room, 630 I Street, Sacramento, CA.

The meeting was adjourned at 5:50 p.m.
