

RESOLUTION APPROVING REPORT AND
AMENDED ASSESSMENT NO. 2607

WHEREAS, a petition for an Amended Assessment of a certain parcel of land assessed in that certain Street Improvement Proceeding Numbered, RESOLUTION OF INTENTION NO. 2607 for the construction of concrete curbs, gutters, sidewalks, sewers, drainage facilities, water system and an asphaltic concrete pavement on on Streets, Ways, Avenues and Right-of-Ways within and adjacent to Meadow Lane Park (as the same is shown on the official Plat thereof filed in the office of the Sacramento County Recorder), in the City of Sacramento, was filed with the City Council of the City of Sacramento under the provisions of Streets and Highways Code Sections 8730 to 8734 inclusive, and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Sacramento duly and regularly directed the Superintendent of Streets, to file his Report and Amended Assessment together with a Map showing how said parcel of land has been subdivided, and

WHEREAS, E. A. FAIRBAIRN, Superintendent of Streets, filed with the City Clerk a Report and Amended Assessment together with a Map showing how said parcel has been subdivided, and

WHEREAS, the Clerk pursuant to the provisions of said Streets and Highways Code, did duly and regularly give notice of the filing of said Report and the fixing of a time for hearing objections to the Report and the Amended Assessment and Map so filed, and

WHEREAS, said Report, Amended Assessment and Map are now on for hearing at the meeting held this 22nd day of July, 1954, in the Council Chambers of the City Council of the City of Sacramento, and



NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that notice of this hearing was given in the manner and for the time provided by Law, and that the Report and Amended Assessment of E. A. Fairbairn, Superintendent of Streets, filed with the City Clerk on July 2nd, 1954, apportioning Assessment No. 116, in Street Improvement Proceedings No. 2607, according to the benefits to the several parts of the lands originally affected by said Assessment No. 116 into eight (8) parcels, be, and the same is hereby approved and confirmed, and that the City Clerk file said Amended Assessment with the Auditor of the City of Sacramento and that collections of unpaid installments of said Original and Amended Assessment No. 116, shall be made in accordance therewith as provided by Law.
