SUBJECT: Nielsen Park CIP - Budget Amendment and Authorization to Waive  
Competitive Bids

#### SUMMARY

This report provides information relating to the Del Paso Regional Park post and cable barrier protection project. A budget amendment is requested and approval to award a contract without receiving competitive bids.

#### BACKGROUND INFORMATION

The Department of Parks and Community Services applied for and received State grant funds for the replacement of the Nielsen Park play area. The Parks Division recently received a donation of play equipment. This equipment is suitable for Nielsen Park. Removal of the equipment from a local pizza parlor and set-up at Nielsen Park will cost approximately \$12,000. The donor has requested a specific contractor to remove the equipment from his pizza parlor. In view of the fact that the City will be receiving donated equipment valued at \$35,000, authorization to award a contract in an amount not to exceed \$12,000 to Cioli Landscaping without receiving competitive bids is requested.

However, receipt of the donated equipment will reduce the Nielsen Park project costs by at least \$10,000. The donated equipment is of higher quality than was proposed for Nielsen Park. Authorization to transfer the \$10,000 to a new capital improvement project for the installation of post and cable barrier protection for the natural habitat area at Del Paso Park is requested. The Arcade Creek area in Del Paso Park is an environmentally sensitive area and must be protected from vehicle access. An additional amount will be proposed for funding in the FY 1985-86 CIP budget.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the City Council, by resolution:

1. Determine it is in the best interest of the City to suspend competitive bidding in accordance with Sacramento City Code, Section 58.401 (d), and award a contract not to exceed \$12,000 to Cioli Landscaping for the removal and set-up of play equipment for Nielsen Park.
2. That the FY 1984-85 Department of Parks and Community Services CIP budget is hereby amended by adding the Del Paso Park barrier system project.
3. That the FY 1984-85 Department of Parks and Community Services CIP budget is hereby amended by transferring \$10,000 from the Nielsen Park Play Area Project No. 1-01-4581-2245 to the Del Paso Park Barrier System Project No. 1-01-4581-2311.
