APPROVING THE NON-PROFESSIONAL SERVICE AGREEMENT FOR THE "EACH ONE REACH ONE STREET OUTREACH PROGRAM" (G2000300) TO THE ROBERTS FAMILY DEVELOPMENT CENTER FOR AN AMOUNT NOT-TO-EXCEED \$63,900

BACKGROUND

- A. Over the last several years, the city of Sacramento continues to experience an increase in young gang validation and youth gang membership.
- B. The Each One Reach One Street Outreach Program is designed to bring awareness to the community while focusing on identifying individual at-risk youth and assisting them with receiving appropriate services to help them avoid at-risk behaviors.
- C. Through partnerships with community organizations and government entities, Kaiser Permanente strives to benefit the community by addressing issues and concerns that affect overall community health by providing resources to these partnerships in the way of cash grants.
- D. The mission of the Office of Youth Development is to make Sacramento a youth-friendly city and strategically allocating resources where they will be most effective in maintaining a healthy community.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. The Non-Professional Service Agreement contract for the Each One Reach One Street Outreach Program (G02000300) to Roberts Family Development Center for an amount not-to-exceed \$63,900 is approved.
- Section 2. The City Manager, or his designee, authorized to execute the contract, issue required purchase orders, and option to renew.
