## Description/Analysis

**Issue Detail:** In July 2018, the City County Office of Metropolitan Water Planning (CCOMWP, also known as the Water Forum) issued Invitation for Bid No. B19804101001 for rental of equipment necessary for gravel work in the American River. The bid documents included a disclaimer that the project would be cancelled if a necessary permit from the U.S. Department of Reclamation was not issued in time to allow the project to proceed. The permit has not been received, and the project cannot commence without it.

Three bids were received, but the project has been cancelled, therefore, staff is recommending that the City Council reject all bids. A new Invitation for Bid will be issued next summer provided the permit is issued for work to commence.

**Policy Considerations:** City Council action is required to reject bids for a contract of \$100,000 or more.

**Economic Impacts:** None.

**Environmental Considerations:** None.

**Sustainability:** None.

**Commission/Committee Action:** None.

**Rationale for Recommendation:** The project was advertised, and three bids were received and opened on August 8, 2018. However, the required permit has not been issued and the project cannot continue without it. Therefore, there is no need for the equipment.

**Financial Considerations:** Rejecting all bids will have no impact on the City or Water Forum budgets.

**Local Business Enterprise (LBE):** The LBE participation requirement was waived for this bid, and will be waived when the project is re-bid next year in order to maximize the number of responsive bids.
