ABSENT : Commissioner Chenu.


The reading of the minutes of the special meeting of May 22, 1930, was dispensed with.

After a short discussion of this case, Commissioner Maloney moved that the Secretary be instructed to forward the file of the case of Bernice K. Burt to the City Attorney for an opinion as to whether or not she is entitled to resume her work in the City Health Department in accordance with her request dated May 29, 1930, and that the Secretary be instructed to inform the City Attorney that it is the opinion of this Board that Mrs. Burt be permitted to return to work; but inasmuch as there is a legal question involved as to the classification of technically trained employees, that we request a decision in this particular case.
