

RESOLUTION No. 802

Adopted by The Sacramento City Council on date of

November 4th, 1937.

WHEREAS, a consolidated Regular and Special Municipal Election was held in the City of Sacramento on the 2nd day of November, 1937, pursuant to provisions of Resolution No. 708, adopted by the City Council on date of August 5, 1937, at which a certain Referendum Proposition was submitted to the qualified electors of the City of Sacramento; and


