

ORDINANCE NO. 1027, FOURTH SERIES

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 1014 FOURTH SERIES, PASSED JULY 14, 1944, AND ENTITLED: "AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING OUT OF THE REVENUES OF THE FISCAL YEAR COMMENCING JULY 1, 1944, THE AMOUNTS NECESSARY TO MEET THE EXPENDITURE REQUIREMENTS OF THE CITY BASED ON THE BUDGET AS AMENDED FOR THE FISCAL YEAR COMMENCING JULY 1, 1944," BY ADDING A NEW SECTION THERETO, TO BE NUMBERED SECTION 4, AND MAKING THIS ORDINANCE AN EMERGENCY MEASURE TO TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
SACRAMENTO:


SECTION 4: There is hereby appropriated out of the available revenues not included in the 1944-45 budget the sum of \$10,000.00 to be used for the purposes of purchasing the following described property:

E $\frac{1}{2}$ of Lot 7 and the W $\frac{1}{2}$ of Lot 6 in the block bounded by G-H-6th-7th Streets in the City of Sacramento.

SECTION 5: This ordinance, being one appropriating money, is hereby made an emergency measure to take effect immediately.
