

RESOLUTION No. 307

Adopted by The Sacramento City Council on date of
March 14, 1947

WHEREAS, the City Manager is empowered to direct that the Fire Department of this city answer calls to fires without the city at his discretion; and

WHEREAS, the BERT McDOWELL COMPANY is the owner and operator of a large warehouse located at 10th and North B Streets immediately adjoining the city limits and this warehouse is used for storage of canned goods and other grocery items, and is, therefore, in need of fire protection in order to prevent possible loss by fire to the contents of this warehouse; and

WHEREAS, the BERT McDOWELL COMPANY, of Sacramento, California, has made a written application to the City Manager for this protection and has offered to pay the City in return for the service of answering all fire calls by the Fire Department of this city according to its usual practice,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL
OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

That the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to give the necessary orders to the Fire Department of this city to answer all calls on the premises of the BERT McDOWELL COMPANY located at 10th and North B Streets adjoining the city limits, for the year beginning March 15, 1947, up to and including March 14, 1948.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that as consideration for the extension of such service for the period beginning March 15, 1947, and ending March 14, 1948, payment will be made by the Bert McDowell Company to the City of Sacramento of the sum of \$1000.00 as offered by them for this service.
