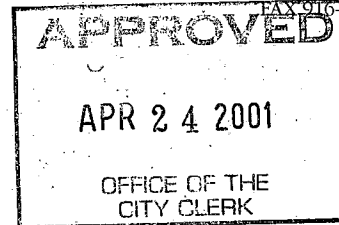

SUBJECT: CONTRACT DATABASE ADMINISTRATOR SERVICES

LOCATION AND COUNCIL DISTRICT: City-wide; all districts

RECOMMENDATION:

This report recommends that the City Council approve Addendum Number 4 to City Manager Agreement #2000-205-1 with ragingmouse.com in the amount of \$44,000, bringing the total compensation to this vendor to \$176,800 for closely related projects.

SUMMARY:

This report recommends that the City Council approve Addendum Number 4 to City Manager Agreement #2000-205-1 in the amount of \$44,000 for contract database administrator services. The original agreement and three addenda total \$132,800. The latest addendum for \$44,000 brings the vendor's total to \$176,800. Prior to Addendum Number 3, ragingmouse.com was known as Carneghe and Gibbs.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

- The contract database administrator services under this agreement will assist the Technology Division in effectively supporting the growing number of installations of Oracle database software throughout the city.
- Oracle databases serve as the foundation for mission-critical applications such as the following:
 - Automated Permits System
 - City Code System
 - Fleet Management System
 - Facility Management System
- The Technology Division has been recruiting for an additional full time data base administrator for over six months without success. Due to staff workload, and the specialized skills needed to perform Oracle support, the Technology Division recommends that additional programming services be provided by ragingmouse.com. Extending the services supplied by ragingmouse.com will provide continuity while we continue to recruit.
- The original Agreement and Addenda 1 and 2 were entered into when the firm was known as Carnegie and Gibbs. The company has since changed its name to ragingmouse.com, but it is a name change only.
- During the original procurement process, several technology firms were requested to submit resumes of qualified database administrators. Ragingmouse.com was the only firm at that time to submit resumes containing the necessary skill set at a reasonable hourly rate.

FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS:

There are several vacant positions in the Technology Division of the Administrative Services Department. Sufficient salary savings exist in the department budget to award this contract.

ENVIRONMENTAL CONSIDERATIONS:

Ongoing administrative and maintenance activities, which are not made for purposes of a public works construction project, do not constitute a "project" and are exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA). CEQA Guidelines, Sections 15061(b)(1), 15378(b)(3).







CONSULTANT AND PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT

This is an addendum to City Manager Agreement No. 2000-205-1 made at Sacramento, California as of April 21, 2000, by and between the City of Sacramento, a municipal corporation ("City") and ragingmouse.com, formerly known as Carnaghe and Gibbs ("Consultant").

Exhibit A - Scope of Services is modified to extend the completion date of services from April 1, 2001 to August 31, 2001.
